

## HOW TO USE THIS Study Guide

The Father's House Study Guide has been designed as a companion guide to the eight week Father's House video-based series. We believe that using this guide will greatly enrich your experience and help take your relationship with Papa God to a deeper, more intimate place.

Each session comes with:

#### **Video Teaching**

Each session is approximately 35 minute long.

#### **Activation**

An activation is a facilitated prayer time designed to help connect your head to your heart.

### **Listening Guide**

The Listening Guide can be used to capture important points while watching the session video and to journal your experience during the Activation.

### **Daily reflections**

Each week has 5 daily reflections that will take approximately 5-10 minutes to complete. Reflections include things such as crafted healing prayers, journal prompts, personal declarations, scripture reflections and our personal favorite... the letters from Papa God on Day 5.

#### **Blueprint for Your Beliefs**

Key scriptures from the content are provided in a variety of translations. We have intentionally used a number of translations to give your heart an opportunity to hear what perhaps has become overly familiar to you in a fresh new way. However, feel free to use whatever translation you are most comfortable with. Ideally you will want to meditate on one or two of these scriptures in the coming week, allowing them to engage you in a conversation with Holy Spirit. You may want to post these in a visible location as a daily reminder of what your Heavenly Father thinks about you!

Final thought...

Throughout the study, we have come to refer to Father God as Abba & Papa God. This simply reflects the heart change that we have gone through in how we now see Him. If you find this offensive, please substitute what feels more natural to you!



The journey starts here...

Its foundation is built on the beliefs, mindsets and behaviors you've cultivated all these years. You may feel really comfortable in the home you've created. The sounds are familiar and the smells are well known. Some cracks may appear in the foundation from time to time, but you know exactly how to cover them. Though, if truth were to be told, you find it hard to rest here. Repairs, renovations and upgrades are constantly needed to make your home measure up. The upkeep can be exhausting.

What if you could set the worries and responsibilities of tending to your home aside? What if you could pick up a yoke that is light and easy instead? The good news is the journey ahead requires nothing but a heart open to experiencing more - more freedom, more intimacy, more joy, more peace and more love.

Can you see up ahead? The path marked Home is littered with what's been released from daughters who are journeying with you. These are the masks torn off the faces who no longer must hide. These are the shoes taken off feet running the race of perfectionism. Here are the bottles of those finished self-medicating their pain. His Home is built on the rock-solid foundation of the Gospel of His AMAZING GRACE. This gospel is rooted in three powerful truths: You are Lavishly Loved, Fully Forgiven and Radically Righteous. Dear Father God,



While your new address is with Father in His house, your beliefs might have some catching up to do! Karen mentioned that her gospel wasn't exactly good news - it was a "Jesus plus" gospel. The result was that she was never quite sure whether all her efforts were truly enough. Her mind had not been renewed to this week's key: "It's not about how good I am, but about how good God is."

Imagine for a moment that you have decided to build a new home. The first thing the builder asks is for your blueprints. The blueprints determine the size of the foundation and ultimately how the house will be framed.

Guess what? Your beliefs are just like the blueprints! They determine the foundation you will build your life upon and "frame up" the life you will lead. Father's House is built on the **extravagant foundation of His amazing Grace**. A life lived in His house is a life of freedom, intimacy, peace and purpose! But here's the catch for most of us. We can't believe that He's actually that good and that this Grace is really that free, so we scale the foundation of our lives down to match our own small, narrow-minded beliefs! A life that is built on any other foundation than His Grace will never result in the abundant life that He longs for you to experience.

In your own words, how would you describe what the Gospel means to you?

#### Read the passage below:

"For I am not ashamed of the Gospel (good news), because it is the **power** of God that brings **salvation** to everyone who **believes**." (Romans 1:16)

What an incredible passage of scripture. **HIS** power brings salvation when you do one thing - simply believe! Now that's what I call good news! But just what exactly does "salvation" encompass? Salvation is so much more than a one-way ticket to heaven or something that you only benefit from in the sweet by and by! Salvation is from the Greek root word "**sozo**".

#### **SOZO** means:

To Rescue To heal (physically, mentally, emotionally, spiritually)

To Deliver To make whole

## FOR OF HIS FULLNESS WE HAVE ALL RECEIVED GRACE UPON GRACE.

[JOHN 1:16 NASB]

What is Grace? Grace is the Greek word "Charis" and means unmerited favor, good will and loving-kindness. Favor means to lean towards, to share a benefit, extending and reaching for, to be gracious.

Grace is so much bigger than simply unmerited favor. These words paint a deeply moving portrait of who your Father God is and what this "Grace upon Grace" looks like. You could say that GRACE looks like Papa God leaning towards you and reaching out for you to give you a bear hug, tell you how much He delights in you and taking you by the hand to show you all the treasures He has for you in His house! The problem is that we have not always believed that He is just that good! Instead, we build our lives on trying to GET His hug, MERIT His delight and QUALIFY for His treasures.

You will need a new mindset - a goodness mindset - to be able to receive all the good things Papa God has for you. The Good News is that Holy Spirit and Jesus are here with you right now to help shift our perspective.

DOES THE GOD WHO LAVISHLY PROVIDES YOU WITH HIS OWN PRESENCE, HIS HOLY SPIRIT, WORKING THINGS IN YOUR LIVES YOU COULD NEVER DO FOR YOURSELVES, DOES HE DO THESE THINGS BECAUSE OF YOUR STRENUOUS MORAL STRIVING OR BECAUSE YOU TRUST HIM TO DO THEM IN YOU?

(GALATIANS 3:5 MSG)

Trust is like the key that unlocks the access to the treasure trove of "Grace upon Grace"- not striving, serving or even obeying! If **striving** lived at one end of the street and **trusting** lived at the other end, where would you say that you are? What/who do you specifically struggle to trust Him with?

In order to move from striving to trusting, you will need to frame your life with good beliefs. Let's ask Jesus, "What are you inviting me to believe about this 'Grace upon Grace'?"

Papa God, thank you for what you are doing in your daughter's heart, mind and body. Thank you that you made receiving your Grace as simple as her trusting You, leaning in for a hug and opening her hands to let go in order to receive!

Sometimes you have to say something new to begin to truly believe something new! We use declarations as an amazing way of partnering with what Papa is already saying about you, your life and your future.

Create your own declarations for this week around Key #1. We will get you started, and then you can add to it:

It's not about how good I am but about how good my God is.

My Father is full of Grace, and He has good things planned for my life.

He's not good to me because I am good, He is good to me because He is good!

He understands where I am on my journey. I'm not behind; I am right on time.

I am open to receive from the fullness of His Grace. I am adventurously expectant.

While this might feel a little awkward to you, we want to encourage you to say these aloud each day! Your own tongue has been created by Papa to bring healing to your mind and your emotions. Let your body feel the beauty of this new Truth. In fact, neuroscience has shown us what God has known all along- that actually visualizing the truth you are declaring aloud, seeing and feeling the truth rather than just repeating it, creates new neural pathways to experience His truth as a living, experiential reality. If you sense some resistance, simply ask: What is the lie that I am believing that you want to uproot?



Dear daughter,

Will you take My hand and follow me? I can't wait to lead you Home. I've prepared a special place there just for you because My Home is not complete without you in it. From before the foundation of the world, I created you, my beloved one. I've counted every hair on your head and captured every tear you've ever cried. You are My beautiful daughter! Did you know that I couldn't be prouder to be your Father? I remember when you took your first steps! You were so full of excitement and anticipation. I was there cheering you on just as I am with you and for you now. As you wobbled and fell, I was there to catch you. Just as I will be there to catch your heart on this journey!

Just like I walked with Adam and Eve in the cool of the garden, my heart has always been to walk intimately with you. I long for you to know Me as I know you - to experience My glory and My extravagant love for you. Your heart is wired to connect with Me. Your ears are intricately designed to hear My voice. Trust the intentional way I've created every piece of you to relate to Me. Remain in Me, and I will remain in you. Never will there be a moment that I leave you or forsake you!

I know right where you are on your journey and the baggage that you have carried for so long. But it's time to begin unpacking those things - it's time to get unstuck! I will be with you every step of the way. This resurrection life you received from God is not a timid grave-tending life. It's adventurously expectant, greeting God with a child like, "What's next, Papa?" God's spirit touches our spirits and confirms who we really are. We know who He is, and we know who we are: Father and children.

### — JOHN 17:3 TPT

Eternal life means to know and experience you, as the only true God, and to know and experience Jesus Christ as the Son whom you have sent.

### — JOHN 10:10 NASB

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that you may have life, and have it abundantly.

### — JOHN 3:16-17 MSG

This is how much God loved the world: He gave His Son, His one and only Son. And this is why: so that no one need be destroyed; by believing in Him, anyone can have a whole and lasting life. God didn't go to all the trouble of sending His Son merely to point an accusing finger, telling the world how bad it was. He came to help, to put the world right again.
